Discrimination means treating certain people unfairly.

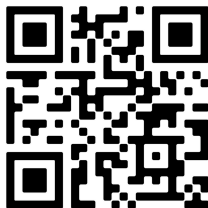
What was the name of Dr. Martin Luther King's famous speech?
